Since 1989 Victoria has been a speaker at women's retreats for churches, PWOC retreats and conferences in Europe, Korea and the United States. Currently living in Sierra Vista, Arizona with her husband, Fred who as a retired Chaplain was recalled to Active Duty as a Family Life Chaplain. Together Fred and Victoria have 4 grown children and 3 grandchildren. Victoria's vocation is to "love women to Jesus and train them in His ways!" Her life verse is Ps 119:32 "I will run in the paths of your commands for you have set my heart free."

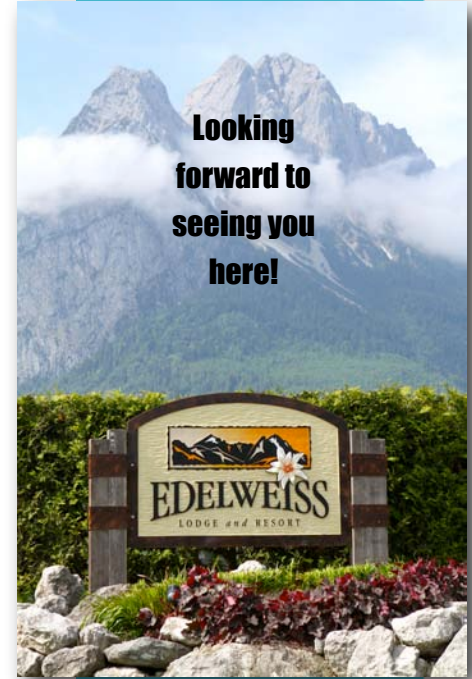
